- ❖ Encourage your child to do their best, to be polite and to develop a sense of responsibility.
- ❖ Provide a caring, safe and secure learning environment.
- ❖ Ensure your child's physical and social wellbeing at all times and to foster feelings of confidence, self worth and belonging.
- ❖ Encourage your child to take care of others and their surroundings.
- ❖ Deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum, which meets the needs of your individual child.
- ❖ Actively welcome parents, carers and families into the life of the Academy.
- ❖ Ensure that all pupils understand and follow the school and class rules.
- ❖ Promote positive behaviour as per the Behaviour Policy.
- ❖ Make sure that all children and their families are treated with respect and sensitivity.

Parental Agreement:

The family/carer will make every effort to:

- ❖ Ensure that your child attends school regularly, on time and properly equipped, and is collected on time (arrive between 08:30 and 08:40, and collect at 15:15 unless he/she is attending an after school club).
- ❖ Notify the Academy by 9.00am on the day of your child's absence and reasons for the absence.
- ❖ Support the Academy's policies, especially the policy for promoting positive behaviour and the Leave of Absence Policy (holidays during term time).
- ❖ Ensure that our child wears the Academy uniform (the uniform list and policy can be found on the parent area of the Academy website)
- ❖ Encourage and support your child in reading, homework and other opportunities for learning at home.
- ❖ Ensure that your child goes to bed at a reasonable time on weekdays to be ready for learning the next day.
- ❖ Keep the Academy informed of any concerns or problems which might affect your child's work or behaviour.
- ❖ Take part in parents evenings and discussions about your child's progress within the academy.

- ❖ Make sure that all staff are treated with respect and sensitivity.
